## Put Your Shorts On! : postponed again


Tier 2 forces us to delay, but we will be back in 2021

We are deeply saddened and disappointed that, due to the placing of Norfolk under Tier 2 restrictions this December, we are forced to postpone, for the second time, our performances of Put Your Shorts On!. Our two casts have been doing a wonderful job of rehearsing over Zoom, and we remain determined to go ahead with the show as soon as Norfolk is allowed to move back into Tier 1 (which will allow for 'rule of six' indoors and our socially-distanced audiences). If you have purchased tickets, we will be in touch very soon to make the necessary arrangements.

As some people have pointed out, Tier 2 allows theatre to be open with socially distanced arrangements and COVID security. However, sadly this applies only to the professional theatre (as it counts as a "place of work" for those involved). The amateur industry has once again ground to a halt, despite the fact that we had all appropriate measures in place for the safety of both audience and performers.

At this stage it's not possible for us to provide alternative dates for the new year, as we are all living with such uncertainty. However, please watch this space, social media and our website for
